SHOW TIME: **Friday, August 12 - 8:30 A.M.**

4-H members must be properly enrolled in the proper beef project to be eligible to show. An individual 4-H member may show:

- 3 Market Animals
- 3 Breeding Heifers
- 3 Stocker Feeder Calves
- 3 Bull Stocker Feeder Calves
- 1 Cow/Calf Pair

Champions will be selected in each breed. A Grand Champion steer and heifer will be selected by the judge from breed champions.

Classes of market cattle and stocker feeder calves will be determined by weight.

Fitting, grooming and clipping may ONLY be done by the 4-H'er or a member of their immediate family. FITTING or BLOW AND SHOW ARE ACCEPTABLE AND OPTIONAL. ALL CALVES MUST BE CLIPPED AND CLEAN.

Entries must be mailed on appropriate forms to the Holt County Extension Office by **July 21.**

Dress Code - 4-H'ers will wear blue jeans, white shirt, or blouse that is long enough to be tucked in with a 4-H emblem. A 4-H tee shirt with sleeves, a 4-H emblem on the pocket or blouse front or a 4-H arm band will be acceptable. Hard soled shoes or boots must be worn for all the 4-H livestock shows. No hats or other headgear except for western hats during the horse show.

This year this attire will be the policy for interview judging, livestock shows, livestock auction, and award ceremonies. Shooting Sports will wear their attire for their events and awards.

Failure to comply with this policy will result in loss of premium money and awards. Superintendents and fairboard members will enforce this policy.

SPECIAL AWARDS

Polled Hereford

The Nebraska Poll-ettes are making available a Poll-Ette Award for the best Polled Hereford.

A Poll-Ette Plaque is awarded for the Best Polled Hereford Breeding Heifer. If either the Champion Market Steer or Champion Market Heifer of the show is a Polled Hereford, they are each eligible for the award.

To qualify for the award, 4-H and FFA members must meet the following list of qualifications.

1. The animal must be NATURALLY POLLED with a clean, smooth head and NO SCURS.
2. Breeding animal must be at least a blue ribbon winner to qualify.
3. The exhibitor must adhere to the principles of good sportsmanship and good showmanship.

Selection of the winners is made by the judge of the show.

2. A bucket calf is an orphan, or newborn calf born after January 1 and before June 1, 2011 male or female; dairy, beef or cross; and fed on bucket or bottle.

3. REMINDER - Bucket Calves MUST be entered Thursday August 11 by 3:00 P.M. They will be dismissed Saturday, August 13 beginning at 4:00 P.M.

4. Exhibitors will sign up for interview times before 9:30 A.M. Friday. Interviews will begin at 10:00 A.M. and continue until all exhibitors have finished. Calves will then be presented to the public during the noon break. All judging will have been done prior to that time.

5. Calves must be at least 70 days old at county fair time.

6. Ranking will be done on the following basis:

- a. Evaluation of completed record book - 35%.
- b. Evaluation of members knowledge by interview - 35%.
- c. Health, condition and quality of animal - 15%.
- d. Evidence of training and showing - 15%.

7. Exhibitors in Bucket Calf are not eligible for beef showmanship.

Record Books should be turned in to the Extension Office by July 21.

SECOND YEAR MARKET BUCKET CALF

This class will be evaluated similarly to the Bucket Calf class including the following:

- 1) Completed record book
- 2) Knowledge by interview
- 3) Health, quality and condition of calf, and
- 4) Evidence of training and showing

Calf must have been identified as a bucket calf the prior year. Age divisions are the same as for the first-year bucket calf project.

Market Bucket Calves should be weighted on Market Beef Weigh Day in March. They will be weighed again on entry day at the fair.

Record books should be turned into the Extension Office by July 14.

Exhibitors will sign up for interview times before 9:30 A.M. Friday. Interviews will begin at 9:30 A.M. and continue until all exhibitors have finished. Calves will **then** be presented to the public during the noon break. All judging will have been done prior to that time.

Exhibitors in Bucket Calf classes are not eligible for beef showmanship with their bucket calf project calves.
